Our sensory room offers a calm, soothing environment that helps reduce anxiety and improve focus, while our occupational therapy room encourages physical development and sensory integration.

We offer a full-day programme from 07:30 to 13:30, as well as aftercare from 13:30 to 16:30, providing a safe and nurturing space for children to grow and flourish.

EARLY SETTLEMENT DISCOUNT

Parents who pay the annual school and aftercare fees IN FULL before the start of school in January are entitled to a discount of R2000.

SCHOOL REGISTRATION FEE
